

Creating Notes in Moodle

Moodle allows for the creation of personal notes within the web browser version. You can view notes in the Moodle mobile app, but cannot create or edit notes.

To create a note, click on your name under the respective course participants list. On your profile page, select the Notes feature in the Miscellaneous category as shown to the right (your screen may look different due to a different theme applied to your course):



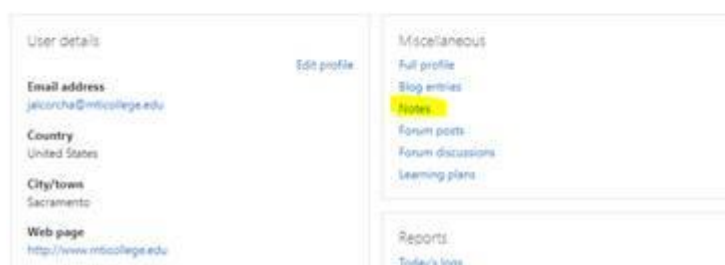
